**Interims** went home this past Friday. Be sure that you have signed the paper and returned it to the teacher.

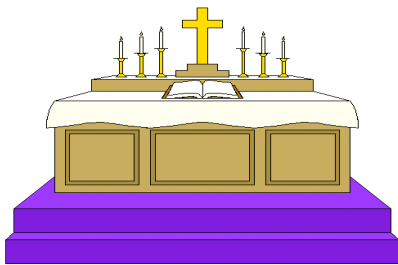

WEDNESDAYS are MASS DAYS!

Please remember that every Wednesday is Mass day at SVF. The students begin the school day at Holy Mass over in the church (off the Kenwood Rd. entrance) at 8:20 in the morning. Grades 1-8 participate in weekly Mass all year long. If your child (Grades 1-8) is LATE for school – arriving after 8:15 AM on Wednesday mornings, you will need to drive them over to the church and walk them in to meet their class there.

Kindergarten students begin attending Mass once a month in November – Mrs. Dunkley will inform Kindergarten parents of their Mass schedule.

Preschool students do not attend weekly Mass.

If a Preschool Student or Kindergarten Student arrives LATE (after 8:15) on a Wednesday morning, they will need to be taken to the Kindergarten door entrance - at the end of the side walk, by Father's house off the Kenwood Rd. entrance. You will need to park and walk your child to the door – KNOCK – Mrs. Dunkley or her aide will let you in. THANK YOU for doing your best to get your children to school on time.

This year, SVF is pleased to welcome our Artist in Residence, Valerie Salstrom from Get Hep Swing in Cleveland. Ms. Salstrom has performed around the world and is a national and an international champion in Swing Dance. She will be sharing her talents with all of our students in grade pre-k through eighth grade. Our 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade core groups will be meeting with Ms. Salstrom every day for an hour, and our students in grades pre-k through 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> through 7<sup>th</sup> will be meeting with her 3 times over the course of her two-week residency.

We will have **two culminating performances**. The first will be **Thursday, October 12<sup>th</sup> at 7:00**, and will **showcase the 4<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade core groups**. Our second culminating performance will be on **Friday, October 13<sup>th</sup> at 8:30 a.m.**, and will **showcase not only our core groups, but all students in grades kindergarten through 8**. We invite **you to join us**. You are sure to be impressed!

Our Artist in Residence program is provided through the generosity of a grant from the Ohio Arts Council. The Ohio Arts Council helped fund this program and others like it throughout the state of Ohio with state tax dollars to encourage economic growth, educational excellence, and cultural enrichment for all Ohioans.
